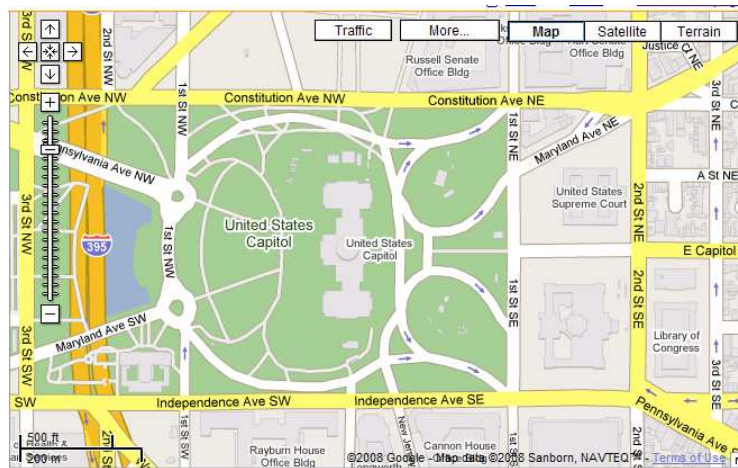


How to update your lat/long in the Safety Net Database

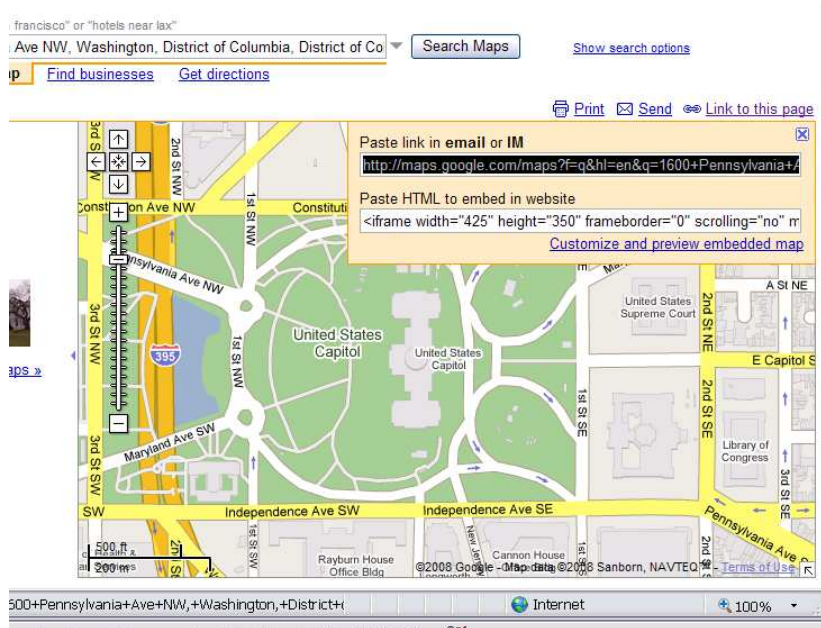
Suppose you are trying to find the latitude and longitude of the U.S. Capitol and by mistake you enter the address of the White House.

Drag the map so that you move the Southeast (you can follow Pennsylvania Avenue). Put the Capitol in the center of the map. (If you zoom in, your lat/long will be more accurate.)
